ANVISA Compliance Letter

Dear Gentlemen:

I declare on for the purposes that the products Cereplast called INJ-Series and TH-Series can be found in accordance with the regulations of Resolution No. 105/99 - General Provisions for Packaging Equipment and Plastics in contact with Food - of ANVISA, and the monomers duly covered by Annex II of this resolution, as well as additives incorporated in the positive list in Annex III to Resolution RDC No. 17/2008.

The additives used in the manufacture of that product in the Positive List of this resolution and some have specific migration limits, so to ensure compliance with Resolution, the packaging and / or equipment plastic end should be examined by the manufacturer and the total limit of migration should be lower than 50 mg / kg or 8 mg/dm², as described in Resolution. Also, remember that manufacturers must ensure that the final article, manufactured in accordance with good manufacturing practices, does not alter the organoleptic properties of the food.
